LOCATION: Sungod Recreation Centre
7815 - 112th Street, Delta BC

FACILITIES:

- 25m, 8 lane Indoor pool with seating for viewing.
- Concession services will be available for breakfast, lunch and snacks on Saturday and Sunday.
- Ample outdoor space for clubs, tests, etc.

Please note:

- Food and drink consumption on deck is limited to meet officials only.
- No glass is permitted inside the pool area.
- Access to any of the amenities offered in Sungod Recreation Centre other than the meet pool itself will require an **admission band**, which can be purchased at the Sungod Service desk in the reception area.
- No “camping” will be allowed inside the facility.
- No parents or guests will be permitted on the working pool deck or within the marshalling area during the meet.
- Events are officially called by the Clerk of the Course in the marshalling area. It is the responsibility of the swimmers to be close enough to hear the Clerk call the events. Any calls made by the announcer over the P.A. system are courtesy calls only.
- Bleachers will be used for active viewing only to ensure viewing access to all. Picnic tables and lawn chairs are not to take up parking spaces.
- Walking paths, doorways and ramps must be kept clear.
- The front parking lot (off of 112th Avenue) will not be available to park in. We ask that no trailers or campers come to our meet, even on a daily basis, as we need to accommodate as much parking as possible.
- **SORRY NO CAMPING OR OVERNIGHT TENTING PERMITTED.**

- All entries received after 9:00 pm on Monday July 24 are considered late.
- Deck entries will be accommodated wherever possible, but may be limited to events with open lanes.
- Deck entries must be received before 7:15 am Saturday July 29.
- Late entries must be paid before the start of the meet.
- Entry fees will be collected from each club on Saturday, July 29.
- Late payment submission will result in missed starts.

ENTRIES:

- Entries must be received before **9:00 pm Monday July 24**.
- All entries must be emailed to Mike Ure - meetmanager@ndsunfish.com (If you do not receive an email confirmation within 24 hours, then we did not receive your entries).
- Entries and team rosters must be submitted in Hy-Tek format.
- Entry submissions must include name & telephone number of club contact and Head Coach.
- Each swimmer may enter 4 individual events and 2 relays.
- No exhibition swims will be allowed.
- **NT will not be accepted.** All swimmers need to have a time submitted with their entry file. If a swimmer has no official time the coach must enter a practice time.
- "O" swimmers must be clearly marked on meet entries.
- Late entries and scratches will be accepted until **9:00 pm Wednesday, July 26**. Please include swimmer's BCSSA number with all late entries. Late fees will apply.
- Coaches must provide the names of swimmers on relays by **10:00 am** on the day of the meet to the Clerk of the Course.

FORMAT:

- Individual events are swum as heats and finals. Finals for top 8 swimmers in Divisions 1- 6.
- Finals will be swum for Division 7 - 8 events if there are more than 8 swimmers in prelims; otherwise all events are timed finals.
- Relays will be raced as timed finals, following individual heats.
- This will be a cardless meet with marshalling.
- Heats will be seeded by division and entry time.
- **2017 BCSSA rules for swimming apply**

RELAYS:

- Division 1-7 "S" relays are open only to "S" swimmers.
- Division 8 relays are open to "S" and "O" swimmers.
- Relay teams must consist of 4 swimmers.
- Names of the 4 swimmers and up two alternates, including their actual Division, **must** be listed on the Official Relay Entry Form.
- "S" swimmers may swim on an "O" Cat Relay: Div 1-3 with "O" Cat 1; Div 4-7 with "O" Cat 2, provided there is a minimum of one (1) "O" Cat swimmer on the Relay.

SCHEDULE:

- Warm-up times: 6:15 am – 7:30 am. Club warmup lanes and times will be assigned prior to the meet.
- Officials Meeting: 7:15 am
- Coaches Meeting: 7:30 am
- Deck Entry deadline: 7:15 am
- Cheers: 7:35 am
- Marshalling begins: 7:50 am

- **Meet begins at 8:00 am sharp**
- There will be a 20 minute warm up between prelims and finals.
- There will be 2 warm-up lanes in the second pool available all day.

AWARDS & SCORING:

Individual Awards:

1. "S" swimmers:
 - a. Tier "A" Finals: 1st to 8th place ribbons up to Division 6
 - b. Tier "B" Based on times swum in preliminaries only. 1st to 8th place ribbons up to Division 6. *Note that 'A' and 'B' are **not** swum separately. The separation is for awards only. Any swimmer with a time fast enough to qualify for finals is eligible.*
2. "O" Category swimmers: Finals: 1st to 3rd place ribbons
3. Relays: 1st to 8th place ribbons
4. 6 and under swimmers registered in 6 and under events will receive goody bags.

Aggregate Awards:

1. Aggregate and runner up aggregate awards for Div. 1 to Div. 6.
2. Aggregate and runner up aggregate awards "O" cat (awarded only if there are 3 or more swimmers entered in 3 or more events)

OFFICIALS:

- Each club will be required to provide timers, recorders, and deck officials. Signup sheets for officials will be sent out prior to, and available during the meet.
- Senior level officials should consider signing up for available Referee, Starter and DDO positions.

RULES:

The BCSSA Rules and Regulations as published in the May 2015 rulebook edition, including any rules passed by the Provincial Board of Directors, which are posted on the BCSSA website, will apply.

All member clubs, competitors, coach, officials or individuals attending the Sunfish Meet shall abide by the Code of Conduct as stipulated in Section 3 Conduct of The Administration of the BCSSA Rules and Regulations and in this meet package. Any members or individuals who violate or fail to comply with the BCSSA Code of Conduct, or rules and regulations may be disciplined at the sole discretion of the Regional Director. Disciplined members or individuals may be appeal to the BCSSA Provincial Board. The decision rendered by the BCSSA Provincial Board on the matter shall be final.

TIMING SYSTEM:

The Omega Timing System will be used as the approved automatic judging and timing system for the Speed Swimming Championships in accordance with BCSSA rules as published May 2013, including any rules passed by the Provincial Board of Directors, which are posted on the BCSSA website. Touch pad and electronic plunger results shall be recorded and reported to 100ths of a second. If a malfunction or light touch invalidates the touch pad results, the electronic plunger results are considered as the Official times. Swimmers with identical Official Times shall be tied both for places and time in accordance with Swimming Section 8 & 9 (Rule Book).
