Facilities: The H20 Aquatic Centre is an indoor 50m, 8 lane pool, which

will be configured as a 25m competition pool There will be 2 lanes designated for warm-up and cool down between

races.

The facility will be open to the public during the meet.

Swimmers and their families may use the water park and gym facilities for the required fee.

Indoor ice arena, library and multi-purpose space next door are in close proximity to the pool.

CAR PARKING will be available in the lot directly in front of H20.

The H20 facility has requested that day camping take place outdoors in the designated areas. (rear parking lot, side grass areas). There will be a soccer tournament taking place in the fields directly behind H20 and we will not have access to the fields this year.

Food: As there is no kitchen or adequate food safe storage on site, there will not be a club funded concession at this meet.

- Jugo Juice concession is available on site with sandwiches, wraps and smoothies.
- Dominos Pizza and Subway are 1 block north on Gordon Drive.
- Snacks and water will be provided to volunteers and officials throughout the meet.

 Swimmers may bring food on deck for personal consumption during the meet.

Club Tents: Tents are allowed to be set up in designated day camping areas on the grass on each side of the facility or in the rear parking lot.

Swimmers are allowed to enter 6 events and 2 relays

This is a timed finals meet

Entry Fees: A flat fee of \$30 per swimmer will be charged, excluding turtles who swim for free. There will be no refunds for scratched swimmers. Payment is expected in full to the meet manager (Ian Murray) by noon Sunday.

Relays: Relay entries must be submitted on proper entry forms to the clerk of the course prior to 10am each day.

Scratches: All BCSSA rules apply or as the Meet manager deems fit and fair.

- This meet will be Timed Finals using jamboree format that combines div 1-3 and 4-8 results. Results be determined by the division.
- Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used to "crash times"
- Swimmers may enter any 6 individual events plus 2 relays.

- Races will be seeded by time within each category on the schedule
- O-Cat 1 and O-Cat2 swimmers will be swimming with their peers in each event
- Best times should be submitted, but only times the swimmer has actually achieved in competition. If no time is available submit no time (NT).
- Heats will be seeded according to times submitted.
- No switching of events once a swimmer is entered.
- Seeding is done by Hy-Tek MM and a minimum of changes to seeding will be done at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course for efficiency.

Division 1-4: Robbons will be awarded to top 16 swimmers Division 5-8 and all relays Ribbons will be awarded to top 8 swimmers

Team Awards will be Top Overall Team Record breaker awards will be given
